Team scheduled projects

Scheduled Tasks

Tuesday March 16th – 1 pm

Meet at Bear Canyon and Tanque Verde Rd to collect aloe for the hummingbird garden at the park

Thursday March 18th – 8:30 am

Meet at the Amphi plant sale holding facility and sort the ocotillos for the sale on Friday into size & price groups

Thursday March 25th – 8:30 am

Meet at the hoop house. Our first task is to plant 3 large ocotillo just west of the bee tree.

Time will likely remain and we will work on planting aloe in the hummingbird garden.

Thursday April 1st – 8:30 am

Meet at the hoop house. We will be planting barrels in small clusters as accents at the new specimen barrel garden.

Unscheduled tasks in the cue

- Construct berms and enlarge some of the ones there as per direction from Linda. The county will be bringing 10 loads of fill dirt. This project will require front loader assistance from our members.
- Construct and hang a bat house on the front of the hoop house.
- Design and construct a water feature near the bottom of the hummingbird garden. Connect a trail camera to observe wildlife visiting the water area at night. Look at the option of a live feed to our TCSS website.
- Design and build direction signs to named areas of the garden.
