The SAGUARO is a HUGE cactus, some are over FORTY feet tall with WHITE flowers and RED fruit.

CHOLLA cactus make great homes for BIRDS, they provide good protection with all their SPINES.

The OCOTILLO blooms provide very good food for humming birds.

Most FISHHOOK BARREL cactus have ORANGE blooms and have YELLOW fruit.

Many of the AGAVE plants die after they send up a BLOOM STALK that may have seeds and bulbils.

PRICKLY PEAR have large red FRUIT that can be picked and made into juice to add to drinks.

Some MOTHS and BATS pollinate cactus blooms that open at night, most night blooms are white.

The small Pincushion cactus has PINK flowers around the CROWN, it usually flowers after a rain.

The Hedgehog cactus is one of the first to bloom in Spring time, many have a MAGENTA color flower.

The Teddy Bear Cholla looks so soft you might want to touch or KISS it, but Don't, that would really hurt.
